What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

Our church is in need of a transformative type pastor who loves redevelopment and who is committed to ministry that focuses on who we are, who God is calling us to be, and where God is calling us to go. The prospective pastor needs to have the appropriate education, degree, and to be certified by the Presbytery as a teaching elder. This foundation shall prepare him/her to lead our church into the 21st century. Additionally, he/she needs to have strong personality characteristics including interpersonal skills, readiness to overcome conflict, emotional and spiritual maturity, flexibility, and the ability to communicate a vision that will empower members of our church to become active leaders. This vision is lived out in community service with leaders who are knowledgeable of God's word and able to live out their faith on a regular basis.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

Our congregation has programs to not only meet the needs of our members, but also of our community. Our programs are geared to meet the spiritual, social, and emotional needs of the people. We have had a preschool on the premises for the past 18 years which is recognized as a premier facility within the community. We have an annual Mexico Mission Trip team that travels to Tijuana each summer to build a new home for a deserving family. This event blesses both the family and the team. In order to fund this endeavor, the trip is preceded by a fundraiser dinner and yard sale each year. Each month our church partners with the Madera Food Bank and gives out food to the citizens of Madera. Every Wednesday we have a "Brown Baggers" lunch that includes bible study, hymns, and fellowship. On the second Saturday of each month, we have the Oasis program where women of the church meet for breakfast, fellowship, bible study, and a craft. We have been involved in the "Adopt a School" program with Madera Unified School District wherein some members would go to the local elementary school and read to the children in the classrooms. Prior to the worship service each Sunday, a group of members meet to pray over the service and the pastor. Our church has also had an active role in the Madera Ministerial Association wherein pastors of Madera churches of all denominations gather monthly to pray and plan events for the community.

We are seeking a compassionate pastor and community leader at ease with public outreach, experienced in congregation building through an advisory capacity, working with the existing membership teaching us how to build Christ's family.
