Our congregation is willing to take risks when trusting and following God.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

Our congregation feels strongly about our community outreach, and feel that we are a beacon of light for community needs. We participate in local charities helping the homeless and poor, and work with many charitable organizations to provide resources. The congregation supports our children and youth programs, as well as local and worldwide mission activities. In addition to providing space for meetings and our 2nd worship service, 210 provides a public forum and meeting place to discuss our communities' most pressing issues.
